#### I. SITUATION OVERVIEW:

At 06:00 PM, the Low Pressure Area (formerly Tropical Depression "Basyang") was estimated based on all available data at 155 km South Southeast of Puerto Princesa City, Palawan (8.4N, 118.4E). Latest analysis indicates that significant re-development of this weather disturbance into a Tropical Depression is still likely.

The Low Pressure Area will bring occasionally gusty winds and scattered light to moderate with at times heavy rains over Palawan, becoming widespread moderate to heavy rains over its southern section. Residents in these areas are advised to continue monitoring for updates, take appropriate measures against possible flooding and landslides, and coordinate with their respective local disaster risk reduction and management offices.

**Sea travel remains risky** over the seaboards of Palawan due to rough to very rough seas associated with the interaction between this disturbance and the Northeast Monsoon.

### II. ACTIONS TAKEN:

NDRRM Operations Center disseminated **Weather Advisory No. 01** to all OCD Regional Offices through SMS and facsimile and uploaded on the NDRRMC website for further dissemination to their respective local DRRMCs from the provincial down to the municipal levels.
