### **I. SITUATION OVERVIEW:**

At 10:00 AM today, the Low Pressure Area (LPA) was estimated, based on all available data, at 50 km Northeast of Guiuan, Eastern Samar (11.3 °N, 126.1 °E). The LPA will continue to bring moderate to occasionally heavy rains over Bicol Region, Eastern Visayas, CARAGA, and the provinces of Aurora and Quezon.

Residents in these areas, especially those living near river channels, in low lying areas and in mountainous areas, are advised to take appropriate action against possible flooding and landslides. Meanwhile, Metro Manila, the rest of Luzon and the rest of Visayas will have occasional light to moderate rains.

The public and Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Offices (DRRMOs) concerned are advised to continue monitoring for updates.


You are hereby directed to monitor the situation and undertake precautionary measures in your area of responsibility (AOR). Likewise, the public and the DRRMCs are advised to take appropriate actions, as necessary.

In order to better inform/warn communities, you are reminded to disseminate these through local/community leaders and through your local media, including community radio stations. Conduct press briefings as often as needed. This local effort will complement and reinforce efforts at the national level. Emphasis should be on proactive actions – evacuation rather than rescue.

Let's untiringly aim for zero casualties.
