I. SITUATION OVERVIEW:

- At 10:00 AM today, the Low Pressure Area (LPA) was estimated, based on all available data, at 50 km Northeast of Guiuan, Eastern Samar (11.3 °N, 126.1 °E). The LPA will continue to bring moderate to occasionally heavy rains over Bicol Region, Eastern Visayas, CARAGA, and the provinces of Aurora and Quezon.
- Residents in these areas, especially those living near river channels, in low lying areas and in mountainous areas, are advised to take appropriate action against possible flooding and landslides. Meanwhile, Metro Manila, the rest of Luzon and the rest of Visayas will have occasional light to moderate rains.
- The public and Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Offices (DRRMOs) concerned are advised to continue monitoring for updates.

II. ACTIONS TAKEN:
