Initial Report re Suspected Food Poisoning in Bontoc, Mountain Province

A. Situation Overview

- On or about 3:00 AM, 06 April 2018, a suspected food poisoning incident transpired at Mountain Province General Comprehensive High School.
- Around 52 people who were Paracelis delegates for the Lang-ay Festival were affected. Out of the 52 people who were reported ill, two (2) victims had episodes of vomiting, stomach ache and diarrhea. The rest had diarrhea and stomach pain only.
- Ms. Lory Cris Pogo-on, school teacher of Paracelis, disclosed that they had boiled meat with wongbok and water from Wendy's Refilling Station at around 8:00 PM of 05 April 2018 for dinner. The meat was bought at the Bontoc Public Market.
- As of 1:00 PM, 06 April 2018, all victims were in stable condition.

C. Actions Taken:

- Bontoc General Hospital Emergency Management Team and Bontoc Medical Health Office staff provided medical treatment to the victims and provided specimen bottles for laboratory inspection. The team was headed by Dr. Carol Yawan. Sanitary inspector checked sources of meat, vegetables and water and inspected food handling.
- Provincial Department of Health Mountain Province provided oresol and other medicines.

- Municipal DRRM Bontoc interviewed the victims and prepared the narrative report.
- OCD CAR prepared initial report and coordinated with DOH CAR and Mountain Province PDRRMO.
