SUBJECT : INITIAL REPORT ON VEHICULAR ACCIDENT IN MALUNGO, SARANGANI PROVINCE

I. SITUATION OVERVIEW:

At around 11:15 AM today, 13 July 2018, a vehicular accident transpired in National Highway at Sitio Buayan, Brgy Malandag, Malungon, Sarangani Province that involved a 6-wheeler truck loaded with 45 passengers coming from Maragaac, Kiblawan, Davao del Sur. Per report the victims are on their way to Maasim, Sarangani Province to attend wedding ceremony when the said truck lost its brake that resulted to the accident.

Thirty eight (38) out of the 45 passengers were immediately brought to Malungon Municipal Hospital consisting of 3 children, 13 adults (female) and 22 adults (male) which 9 of them were severely injured and immediately referred to different hospital in General Santos City and Digos City for proper medical management and 4 victims were declared dead on arrival.

III. ACTIONS TAKEN:

1. MDRRMC-Malungon Rescue Team, BFP-Malungon, PNP-Malungon, Prc-Gen-Sar Chapter, PDRRMO Sarangani and 1002nd Brigade (AFP) responded to the incident area.
2. Malungon Medical Team facilitated the transport of severely injured victims to different hospital in General Santos City and Digos City.
3. The rescue operation was officially cleared by MDRRMO Malungon at about 1:45 PM this afternoon.
