I. SITUATION OVERVIEW:

Tropical Depression "HENRY" has made landfall over Fuga Island, Cagayan.

Occasional rains with gusty winds are expected over the areas under Tropical Cyclone Warning Signal #1.

The **Southwest Monsoon (Habagat)** will bring monsoon rains over Metro Manila, Zambales, Bataan, Cavite, Batangas, Mindoro Provinces, Palawan and Western Visayas and **scattered rainshowers and thunderstorms** over the rest of the country. Residents of these areas, especially those living in **low-lying and mountainous areas**, are advised to continue monitoring for updates, coordinate with their local DRRM offices, and take appropriate actions against possible flooding and landslides.

Fisherfolks and those with small seacrafts are advised not to venture out over the seaboards of areas under TCWS #1 and the western seaboard of Luzon due to moderate to rough seas associated with the approaching Tropical Depression and the Southwest Monsoon.

"HENRY" is expected to exit the Philippine Area of Responsibility (PAR) today (17 July).

Meanwhile, at 1:00 AM today, a Low Pressure Area (LPA) was estimated based on all available data at 845 km East of Infanta, Quezon (15.4 N, 129.5 E)

Location of eye/center:	At 1:00 AM today, the center of Tropical Depression "HENRY" was estimated based on all available data in the vicinity of Fuga Island, Aparri, Cagayan (19.0°N, 121.3°E).
Strength:	Maximum sustained winds of 60 km/h near the center and gustiness of up to 75 km/h
