## I. SITUATION OVERVIEW:

TROPICAL DEPRESSION "JOSIE" IS ABOUT TO MAKE A CLOSE APPROACH OVER THE BURGOS-PAGUDPUD AREA IN ILOCOS NORTE.

- Tropical Depression "JOSIE" will bring scattered to widespread moderate to heavy rains over Ilocos Region, Cordillera Administrative Region, Batanes, Babuyan Group of Islands, Cagayan Valley, Zambales, Tarlac and Nueva Ecija. Meanwhile, scattered light to moderate with occasional heavy rains are expected over Metro Manila, CALABARZON, and the rest of Central Luzon and of Cagayan Valley, and Mindoro Provinces. Residents of these areas, especially those living in low-lying and mountainous areas, are advised to take appropriate actions against possible flooding and landslides, continue monitoring for updates, coordinate with local disaster risk reduction and management offices.
- Sea travel is risky over the seaboards of Northern Luzon and the western seaboard of Central Luzon, especially in areas under Tropical Cyclone Warning Signal #1.

## II. ACTIONS TAKEN

- NDRRM Operations Center disseminated Severe Weather Bulletin No. 03 to all OCD Regional Offices through SMS and facsimile and uploaded on the NDRRMC website for further dissemination to their respective local DRRMCs from the provincial down to the municipal levels.
- Directed RDRRMCs concerned through the OCD Regional Offices to undertake precautionary measures in their areas of responsibility (AOR) and subsequently advised local DRRMCs to initiate pre-emptive evacuation of families in low-lying areas and mountainous areas if situations warrant.
