





Progress Report re Fire Incident at Jolo, Sulu (ARMM)

A. SITUATION OVERVIEW

- On 24 July 2018, at around 3:00 PM, a fire incident simultaneously transpired at the Port Area Barangay Walled City and Brgy. Bus-bus, Jolo, Sulu.
- Fire out was declared at around 2330H of the day day.

B. EFFECTS

- A total of **7,451 families or 35,175 individuals** were affected re the said incident.
- Out of these affected families, **886 families or 4,640 individuals** are currently staying in six (6) evacuation centers in (Brgy Walled City EC, Brgy Bus-bus EC, Jolo Tennis Court EC, Notre Dame Gymnasium EC, Dan Dan Ututalum Elementary School EC, and Phil. Muslim College EC.
- Ten (10) individuals were reported injured
- An estimated number of 1,000 houses were reported damaged

C. ACTIONS TAKEN:

- OCD ARMM coordinated with MDRRMC-Jolo re the said incident.
- BFP-Sulu in close partnership with BDRRMC Bus-bus Response team and volunteer Organization conducted fire suppression.
- OCD-ARMM turned over a total of 1,774 pcs hygiene kits to ARMM-HEART as part of the relief distribution for Jolo, Sulu.
- PRC-Sulu chapter provided first aid to the casualties during the fire incident.
- OCD Central Office coordinated to OCD ARMM for the augmentation of 200 sacks of rice.
- The DSWD-FO IX extended 9,000 family food packs and 2,500 hygiene kits and Malong to the fire victims.

- The DSWD-FO IX will also provide sleeping kits, collapsible water jug with purifying tablets, and kitchen utensils.
 - The PDRRMC-Sulu prepared a total of 3,500 sacks of rice intended to be distributed to the affected families.
 - OCD ARMM is continuously monitoring the said incident.
