I. INITIAL REPORT RE FIRE INCIDENT IN ST BERNARD, SOUTHERN LEYTE

A. SITUATION OVERVIEW

1. At around 2:12 PM, 10 August 2018, the Regional Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Operations Center received an Incident Report from MDRRMO San Francisco, Southern Leyte that a fire incident occurred in St. Bernard, Southern Leyte.
2. The fire broke out at the Market Area in St Bernard, Southern Leyte, which burned six (6) houses and suffocated one (1) firefighter
3. At 2:30 PM of 10 August 2018, the conflagration was declared under control.

B. ACTIONS TAKEN:

ST BERNARD FIRE STATION:

- Responded to the fire scene and conducted fire suppression operations.
- Conducted on-site investigation for the possible cause and total damage of the fire incident.

PDRRMO SOUTHERN LEYTE:

- Monitored the effects of the fire incident.
- Coordinated with St Bernard MDRRMO re veracity of the incident and their submission of report.

MDRRMO ST BERNARD, SOUTHERN LEYTE:

- Monitored the effects of the fire incident.
- Continuous monitoring of the incident.

OCD RO VIII:

- Coordinated with Southern Leyte PDRRMO, St Bernard MDRRMO and BFP Regional Office 8 re Fire Incident in St Bernard, Southern Leyte
- Continuous monitoring of the incident.
