I. SITUATION OVERVIEW:

At 10:00 AM today, the Low Presure Area (LPA) was estimated based on all available data at 785 KM East Northeast of Basco Batanes (23.1°, 129.0°E). This LPA will continue to enhance the Southwest Monsoon (HABAGAT) which will bring scattered to with widespread monsoon rains over Ilocos Region, Cordillera Administrative Region, Batanes, Babuyan Group of Islands, Zambales and Bataan while light to moderate to at times heavy rains over Metro Manila, CALABARZON, and the rest of Central Luzon.

Residents of these areas, and especially those living near river channels, in low-lying areas, and in mountainous areas, are still advised to take appropriate actions against possible flooding and landslide, coordinate with local DRRM Offices, and continue monitoring for updates.

The next update on this weather system will be incorporated in the 24-Hour Public Weather Forecast at 4:00 PM today and 4:00 AM tomorrow.

The next weather advisory will be issued at 11:00 AM tomorrow.
