I. REPORT RE XIAMEN AIR FLIGHT MF8667

A. SITUATION OVERVIEW

 On or about 2355H 16 August 2018, Xiamen Air flight MF8667 went off the runway during heavy downpour. All 157 passengers and flight crew are safe. Investigators from the CAAP Aircraft Accident Investigating Bureau is already on site to determine the cause of the accident.

Passengers were evacuated using th aircraft's emergency chute and were brought to NAIA Terminal 1 where they are now being assisted by airline and Miaa personnel. Blankets and food were provided by the airline. As of press time, passengers are being transported to a nearby hotel until operations of Xiamen Air resumes.

MIAA GM Ed Monreal and CAAP DG Jim Sydiongco are personally coordinating with the airline officials while supervising recovery and clearing operations on site.

Responding units from MIAA are Fire and Rescue, Medical, Operations, Safety and Airport police.

 On 18 August 2018, Xiamen Air aircraft was transported to the Balagbag ramp after being lifted from the site of incident.

A final extension of runway closure until 12 noon today is necessary to give way for the demobilization of heavy equipment used to lift the aircraft. Simultaneously, clearing the runway of debris and other foreign objects will also be done.
