I. Report on Vehicular Incident in Hilongos, Leyte

A. SITUATION OVERVIEW

 Approximately 2022H of August 23, 2018 OCD VIII received a report of a vehicular accident that transpired at the intersection of National Highway in Barangay Magnangoy and Barangay Naval, Hilongos, Leyte last 21 August 2018 involving a UV Express and a Delivery Van.

B. EFFECTS

• As a result of said incident, one (1) dead person and ten (10) injured persons was reported

Final Report re Fire Incident in Glory Mountain, Upper 6 Tamayong, Davao City A. SITUATION OVERVIEW

 On 15 August 2018, 1104H, a forest fire incident was reported in Glory Mountain, Upper 6 Brgy. Tamayong, Davao City. Calinan fire station, BFP SRU, Central 911, Davao Firefighters Rescue Services and Quiboloy Rescue Team jointly conducted firefighting operation. Initial investigation revealed that the fire started on August 12, 2018, spread gradually and destroyed approximately five (5) hectares of land owned by Pastor Apollo C. Quiboloy.

B. EFFECTS

2. The fire incident razed more or less five (5) hectares of planted trees and natural forest grown trees and the damage was estimated at **pesos two hundred thousand** (₱200,000).

C. ACTIONS TAKEN:

- 3. Calinan Fire Station with BFP, Davao Central 911 Auxiliary Service, USAR, EMS and Fire Volunteers conducted fire suppression, cooling technique and establish fire line.
- 4. DENR XI sent nine (9) personnel with fire swatter and PPEs to the affected area.
- 5. OCD XI conducted coordination with Davao CDRRMC and BFP XI for situation update.
