SITUATION OVERVIEW:

The Low Pressure Area (LPA) was estimated, based on all available data, at **495km east of Juban, Sorsogon (12.4°N,128.5°E)**. This weather system will bring scattered light to moderate rainshowers and thunderstorms over Metro Manila, MIMAROPA, CALABARZON, and whole of Visayas.

Northern Palawan (Calamian Islands), Antique, Occidental Mindoro and the Samar Provinces will likely experience frequent light to moderate rainshowers and thunderstorms until tonight. Residents in these areas, especially those living near river channels, in low lying areas and in mountainous areas, are advised to take appropriate action against possible flooding and landslides, coordinate with Local Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Offices and continue monitoring for updates.

The LPA is expected to dissipate within the next 12-24 hours and become embedded in the trough of the approaching Typhoon (Jebi). With this development, this is the final advisory for this weather system.

The next update on this weather system will be incorporated in the 24-hour Public Weather Forecast at 4:00 PM this afternoon.


You are hereby directed to monitor the situation and undertake precautionary measures in your area of responsibility (AOR). Likewise, the public and the DRRMCs are advised to take appropriate actions, as necessary.

In order to better inform/warn communities, you are reminded to disseminate these through local/community leaders and through your local media, including community radio stations. Conduct press briefings as often as needed. This local effort will complement and reinforce efforts at the national level. Emphasis should be on proactive actions – evacuation rather than rescue.

Let's untiringly aim for zero casualties.
