I. Initial Report regarding Flooding Incident in the Province of Capiz (REGION VI)

A. SITUATION OVERVIEW

- Flashfloods occurred due to heavy rains brought by the Low Pressure Area causing several areas flooded in the Province of Capiz including Roxas City and eight (8) barangays. On 2:30 PM, 31 August 2018, floodwater was subsided.

B. EFFECTS

- A total of eight (8) flooded areas in Roxas City:
 - Tiza (Road at Malipayon Village, Camansi St.)
 - Inzo (portion of Mabini, Burgos and San Roque St.)
 - Barangay II (portion of Bangbang St.)
 - Lawaan
 - Banica
 - Sibaguan
 - Tanque (portion of Kalobihan and Ilaya)
 - Barangay IV (portion of Burgos St.)
- Suspension of Classes:
 - Roxas City – All levels
 - Dumalag Central School

C. ACTIONS TAKEN

- PDRRMC – OpCen continuously monitoring of weather situation in the whole province 24/7

- PDRRMC and CERT conducted ocular inspection at Tiza, Roxas City regarding the incidents.

II. Initial Report regarding Effects of Low Pressure Area (REGION VIII)

A. SITUATION OVERVIEW

- At 3:00 PM, 31 August 2018, the Low Pressure Area (LPA) was estimated based on all available data at 200 km East of Catbalogan City, Samar (11 .9 N, 126.7 E).

B. EFFECTS

C. ACTIONS TAKEN

RDRRMC MEMBER AGENCIES

PNP PRO VIII

- Alerted line units to monitor the effects of the LPA through Radio Communication

PCG Eastern Visayas

- Advised CG Stations in the region to monitor their respective AORs on the effects of the LPA

AFP, Tactical Operations Group (TOG)-8

- Alerted the Group's Search, Rescue and Recovery (SRR) Team for possible deployment

OCD VIII

- Coordinated with the P/C/MDRRMOs re status of weather condition in their AOR.
- Coordinated with the LDRRMOs especially in Eastern Samar regarding the incidents monitored and actions taken re LPA.
- Continuous monitoring for any untoward incident.

PDRRMC SOUTHERN LEYTE

- Activated 24/7 EOC to monitor updates.
- Advised DRRMOs to take precautionary measures to vulnerable communities.
- Disseminated advisories to the LCEs, DRRMOs and PDRRMC members.

PDRRMC NORTHERN SAMAR

- Alerted MDRRMOs to take precautionary measures
- Activated 24/7 OPCEN to monitor the effects of LPA

- Disseminated weather advisories to the LCEs and MORRMOs

PDRRMC BILIRAN

- Coordinated with MDRRMCs re LPA
- Continuous monitoring of the flood-prone areas
- Disseminated weather advisories to the MDRRMOs

PDRRMC LEYTE

- Coordinated with MDRRMCs re LPA

PDRRMC SAMAR

- Coordinated with MDRRMCs re LPA
- Continuous monitoring of the flood-prone areas
- Disseminated weather advisories to the MDRRMOs

PDRRMC EASTERN SAMAR

- Activated 24/7 OPCEN
- Continuously monitoring the effects of LPA
- Alerted ERTs for possible deployment
- Disseminated weather advisories to the MDRRMOs

MDRRMC GUIUAN, EASTERN SAMAR

- Conducted survey on the flood-prone areas and schools
- Continuously monitoring the effects of LPA

MDRRMC HERNANI, EASTERN SAMAR

- Alerted Brgy. Captains to monitor the flood-prone areas
- Continuously monitoring the effects of LPA

MDRRMC SALCEDO, EASTERN SAMAR

- Coordinated to the barangays to monitor weather conditions
- Continuous monitoring the effects of LPA

III. Progress Report re Fire Incident at Barangay Poblacion, Lanao del Norte (Region X)

A. SITUATION OVERVIEW

- On 12:20 PM, 29 August 2018, a fire incident occurred at a residential/commercial buildings in P-1A Barangay Poblacion, Linamon Lanao del Norte.
- The fire started at 12:20 PM, 29 August 2018 and declared fire out at 2:29 PM, same day.
- The cause of fire is yet to be determined.

B. EFFECTS

- A total of 73 families were affected due to fire incident:

- A total of 54 houses were damaged and an estimated cost of damages amounting to PhP8,000,000.00

C. ACTIONS TAKEN

- BFP Iligan, Bacolod, Kauswagan together with AFP, PNP, PDRRMO Lanao del Norte, MSWDO Linamon, Red Cross Tanker, Barangay Poblacion Officials and Volunteers responded to the incident.
- PDRRMC, PSWDO Lanao del Norte, MSWDO Linamon, Brgy. Poblacion, Linamon provided family packs and conducted feeding program to the affected families.
