





I. Incident Report re Water Scarcity Due to Drought in the Municipality of Virac, Catanduanes (Region V)

A. SITUATION OVERVIEW

- Due to prolonged dry weather, water scarcity is currently being experienced in nineteen (19) Barangays in the Municipality of Virac, Catanduanes.

B. EFFECTS

Affected Population

- As of 04 September 2018, a total of 5,012 households were affected in nineteen (19) Brgys. In Virac Catanduanes.
- A total of 482 farmers were affected.

Declaration of State of Calamity

- On 28 August 2018, the Municipality of Virac, issued Municipal Resolution Number 2018-08-256 declaring Virac, Catanduanes under State of Calamity.

C. ACTIONS TAKEN

OCD RO V

- Coordinated with MDRRMO Virac re possible interventions of the Regional DRRM Council
- Continuous monitoring of the situation

LGU Virac

- Continuous conduct of assessment to the affected Barangays
- Intensified Information, Education and Communication Campaign (IEC) on Water Sanitation and Hygiene (WASH)
- Continuous conduct of water sampling
- Delivered a total of 12,000 liters of safe drinking water at Brgy. San Isidro Village.
