I. SITUATION OVERVIEW:

- At 10:00 AM today, the Low Pressure Area (LPA) was estimated, based on all available data in the vicinity of **Basco, Batanes (20.1°N, 121.9°E)**. This weather system will bring **moderate to occasionally heavy rains and thunderstorms** over **Batanes and Babuyan Group of Islands** while **scattered light to moderate rains** over **Cagayan, Apayao, Abra, Kalinga and Ilocos Region**. Residents in these areas, especially those **living near river channels, in low lying areas and in mountainous areas**, are advised to **take appropriate action** against possible flooding and landslides, coordinate with local disaster risk reduction and management offices and continue monitoring for updates. The LPA may develop into a Tropical Depression (TD) **within 24 to 48 hours**.
- The next update on this weather systems will be incorporated in the 24-hour public weather forecast at 4:00 PM this afternoon and 4:00 AM tomorrow.

II. ACTIONS TAKEN:

- NDRRM Operations Center disseminated **Weather Advisory No. 02** to all OCD Regional Offices through SMS and facsimile and uploaded on the NDRRMC website for further dissemination to their respective local DRRMCs from the provincial down to the municipal levels.
