I. SITUATION OVERVIEW:

- At 10:00 AM today, the Low Pressure Area (LPA) was estimated, based on all available data in the vicinity of Basco, Batanes (20.1°N, 121.9°E). This weather system will bring moderate to occasionally heavy rains and thunderstorms over Batanes and Babuyan Group of Islands while scattered light to moderate rains over Cagayan, Apayao, Abra, Kalinga and Ilocos Region. Residents in these areas, especially those living near river channels, in low lying areas and in mountainous areas, are advised to take appropriate action against possible flooding and landslides, coordinate with local disaster risk reduction and management offices and continue monitoring for updates. The LPA may develop into a Tropical Depression (TD) within 24 to 48 hours.
- The next update on this weather systems will be incorporated in the 24-hour public weather forecast at 4:00 PM this afternoon and 4:00 AM tomorrow.
