I. SITUATION OVERVIEW:

TYPHOON MANGKHUT HAS MAINTAINED ITS STRENGTH AS IT MOVES WEST NORTHWESTWARD.

- The typhoon continues to threaten Northern Luzon.
- The provinces of Catanduanes and Camarines Sur will experience the peripheral effects of "OMPONG" within 36 hours bringing occasional rains and gusty winds.
- The typhoon may reach a peak intensity of 220kph / 270kph (max/gust) tomorrow (September 13).
- TY "OMPONG" is expected to make landfall in the northern tip of Cagayan on Saturday (September 15).
- Possible Inclusion to Tropical Cyclone Warning Signal (TCWS) #1 over the provinces of Cagayan, Isabela, Aurora, Quirino, Polilio Islands, Camarines Norte and Albay tomorrow morning (September 13).
- Fisherfolks and those with small seacrafts are advised not to venture out over the seaboards of areas under TCWS#1 and the eastern seaboards of Visayas and Mindanao.

	At 10:00 PM today, the center of Typhoon "OMPONG" was located based all available data at 1,005 km East of Virac, Catanduanes (14.3N, 133.5E).			
Strength:	Maximum sustained winds of up to 205 km/h near the center and gustiness of up to 255 km/h.			
Movement:	Moving West Northwest at 20 km/h			
Forecast Positions:	24 Hour (Tomorrow evening): 875 km East of Baler, Aurora (15.1°N, 129.7°E).			

- 48 Hour (Friday evening): 365 km East of Tuguegarao City, Cagayan (17.1°N, 125.1°E).
- 72 Hour (Saturday evening): 135 km Northwest of Laoag City, Ilocos Norte (19.0°N, 119.6°E).
- 96 Hour (Sunday evening): 840 km West of Basco, Batanes (OUTSIDE PAR) (20.8°N, 113.9°E).
- 120 Hour (Monday evening): 1,510 km West of Basco, Batanes (OUTSIDE PAR) (21.7°N, 107.5°E).
