I. Initial Report re Warehouse Fire Incident in Calatrava, Romblon

A. SITUATION OVERVIEW

- On or about 0920H 18 September 2018, a fire broke out in the warehouse of Mr. Bernie Motin at Brgy Poblacion, Calatrava, Romblon.
- BFP Calatrava, MDRRMO Calatrava and local volunteers immediately responded to the fire. The incident was declared fire out at 0950H of the same date.
- The fire was allegedly caused by the irresponsible lighting of fire by a vagrant with suspected mental illness roaming the area.
- The fire razed fishing nets and motorboat engines/motors placed inside the warehouse, with damages amounting to approximately Php500,000.00 based on the estimates of the warehouse owner.

B. ACTIONS TAKEN

- BFP Calatrava, MDRRMO Calatrava and local volunteers immediately conducted fire suppression of the incident.
- MDRRMO Calatrava coordinated with OCD MIMAROPA re the incident.
- OCD MIMAROPA coordinated with BFP and MDRRMO Calatrava for updates and monitoring of the incident.

II. Initial Report re Miss World Philippines 2018 Beach Beauty Competition

A. SITUATION SUMMARY

- **OVERVIEW:** The Municipality of El Nido, Palawan has been designated as the “Tourist Destination” partner of the Miss World Philippines (MWP) 2018 Beauty Pageant Beach Fashion and Swimsuit Pictorial and Competition that will be held on September 18-21, 2018

at the El Nido Municipal Covered Court, El Nido, Palawan. A total of forty (40) candidates are expected to join the competition. RDRRMC MIMAROPA, through the leadership of OCD MIMAROPA, has activated the Task Group Emergency Preparedness and Response (TGEPR) and activated the Incident Management Team (IMT), in coordination with the El Nido LGU, to ensure the safe and peaceful conduct of this high-density population gathering.

- **PREVAILING WEATHER:** [On 18 September 2018, the prevailing weather in El Nido, Palawan is sunny.
