I. SITUATION OVERVIEW:

TYPHOON "PAENG" REMAINS QUASI-STATIONARY WHILE MAINTAINING ITS STRENGTH.

- Sea travel remains risky over the northern and eastern seaboards of Luzon and the eastern seaboard of Visayas.
- PAENG is expected to exit the Philippine Area of Responsibility (PAR) on Saturday morning (29 Sep).

Location of eye / center:	At 10:00 AM today, the eye of Typhoon "PAENG" was located based on all available data at 750 km East of Basco, Batanes (21.5°N, 129.1°E).
Strength:	Maximum sustained winds of up to 160 km/h near the center and gustiness of up to 195 km/h.
Movement:	Moving almost stationary.
Forecast Positions:	 24 Hour (Tomorrow morning): 640 km East Northeast of Basco, Batanes(22.4°N, 127.8°E) 48 Hour (Saturday morning): 670 km Northeast of Basco, Batanes (OUTSIDE PAR) (25.2°N, 126.0°E) 72 Hour (Sunday morning): 1,220 km Northeast of Basco, Batanes (OUTSIDE PAR)(29.4°N, 129.0°E)
