I. SITUATION OVERVIEW:

TYPHOON "PAENG" IS SLOWLY MOVING IN A NORTHWEST DIRECTION WHILE MAINTAINING ITS STRENGTH.

- Sea travel remains risky over the northern and eastern seaboards of Luzon and the eastern seaboards of Visayas.
- "PAENG" is expected to exit the Philippine Area of Responsibility (PAR) on Saturday morning (29 September).

Location of eye/center	At 10:00 AM today, the eye of Typhoon "PAENG" was located based on all available data at 655 km East Northeast of Basco, Batanes (22.7°N, 127.8°E).
Strength	Maximum sustained winds of up to 160 km/h near the center and gustiness of up to 195 km/h.
Movement	Moving Northwest slowly.
Forecast Positions	 24 Hour (Tomorrow morning): 705 km Northeast of Basco, Batanes (Outside PAR) (25.1°N, 126.6°E) 48 Hour (Sunday morning): 1,355 km Northeast of Basco, Batanes (Outside PAR) (30.0°N, 130.3°E)
