I. Background:

A major earthquake with a preliminary magnitude of 6.7 occurred in Hokkaido, Japan on 06 September 2018 at 02:07 AM (Philippine Standard Time) located at 42.7°N, 142.0°E with depth of 39 km. No destructive tsunami threat exists based on available data.

This is for information purposes only and there is no tsunami threat to the Philippines from this earthquake.

You are hereby directed to undertake precautionary measures and monitor the situation in your AOR. Likewise, the public and NDRRMCs concerned are advised to take appropriate actions.

In order to better inform/warn communities, you are reminded to disseminate these through local/community leaders and through your local media, including community radio stations. Conduct press briefings as often as needed. This local effort will complement and reinforce efforts at the national level. Emphasis should be on proactive actions – evacuation rather than rescue.

Let's untiringly aim for zero casualties.
