I. Background:

A strong earthquake with a preliminary magnitude of **6.8** occurred in **Fiji Region** on **30 September 2018** at **6:52 PM** (Philippine Standard Time) located at **18.3°S, 178.0°W** with depth of **591 km**. No destructive tsunami threat exists based on available data.

This is for information purposes only and there is **no tsunami threat** to the Philippines from this earthquake.

II. ACTIONS TAKEN:

- NDRRMC Advisory on the earthquake information was disseminated to **OCD I, II, III, CALABARZON, MIMAROPA, V, VI, VII, VIII, IX, X, XI, XII, CARAGA, CAR, NCR, and ARMM** through facsimile, SMS and website for further dissemination to their respective Local Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Councils (LDRRMCs) from the provincial down to the municipal levels.
- DOST-PHIVOLCS is closely monitoring the situation and any new significant development will be immediately relayed to all concerned.
