Initial Report re Fire Incident in Brgy. Bago Gallera, Davao City (Region XI)

A. SITUATION OVERVIEW

- At 12:30 PM, 26 October 2018, a fire incident occurred in Purok 15, Kabataan Village, Brgy. Bago Galera, Davao City but was declared fire out at 01:20 PM.
- Ongoing investigation is being conducted to determine the cause of the incident

B. EFFECTS

- A total of <u>17 families / 85 persons are affected</u>. Affected families stayed at the Barangay Chapel while others opted to stay with their relatives within the area.
- A total of fifteen (15) houses were damaged, of which, twelve (12) were totally damaged while three (3) houses were partially damaged houses
- Cost of damagas is yet to be determined.

C. ACTIONS TAKEN

- OCD XI is in coordination with Davao City DRRMC and DSWD XI for situation update.
- BFP with Davao Central 911 Fire Auxiliary Service and fire volunteers conducted fire suppression.
- CSSDO Davao City provided Food Packs and Non-Food items to the affected families.

Initial Report re Armed Conflict Incident in Shariff Saydona Mustapha, Maguindanao (ARMM)

A. SITUATION OVERVIEW

 At 2:14 PM, 26 October 2018, an armed encounter between AFP and lawless group transpired in Sitio Talitay, Brgy Inaladan, Shariff Saydona Mustapha, Maguindanao

B. EFFECTS

 A total of <u>146 families / 730 persons</u> were affected in the Shariff Saydona Mustapha, Maguindanao with breakdown as follows:

C. ACTIONS TAKEN

OCD ARMM

- Coordinated with MDRRMO-SSM and PDRRMO-Maguindanao
- Coordinated with DSWD-Maguindanao re affected population in SSM.
- In continuous dissemination of reports, coordination with concerned RDRRMC memberagencies and close monitoring of the situation

Progress Report re Flooding Incident in Maguindanao (ARMM)

D. SITUATION OVERVIEW

• The Municipalities of Datu Abdullah Sangki, Pagalungan, and Datu Montawal experienced continuous light to moderate rains which caused flooding in twenty-seven (27) barangays.

E. EFFECTS

 A total of <u>7,930 families / 39,650 persons</u> were affected by the flooding incident in Maguindanao. Further, a total of <u>166 families / 830</u> persons are currently seeking refuge at Poblacion Solar Dryer, Brgy. Bakat, Shariff Saydona Mustaph. No reported casualites.

F. ACTIONS TAKEN

OCD ARMM

- Close coordination with all PDRRMC in ARMM.
- Coordinated with Local DRRM Council for effects of the Intertropical Convergence Zone (ITCZ) in Maguindanao.

- Continuous monitoring is being conducted by ARMM-HEART and OCD-ARMM 24/7 Operation Center.
- MDRRMO-Pagalungan in partnership with MSWDO-Pagalungan conducted assessment and validation of affected families in their area.
- OCD-ARMM in coordination with DAF-ARMM requested data re the agricultural land area affected by flooding in Maguindanao.

DSWD Maguindanao

- Conducted monitoring, assessment, and validation of the affected barangays.
- Municipal responders/volunteers on stand-by for possible deployment.
