
**TROPICAL DEPRESSION "SAMUEL" HAS SLIGHTLY INTENSIFIED AS IT MOVES WESTWARD OVER THE WEST PHILIPPINE SEA.**

- All Tropical Cyclone Warning Signals have been lifted. However, fisherfolks and those with small seacrafts are still advised not to venture out over the northern and western seaboard of Luzon
- "SAMUEL" is expected to exit the Philippine Area of Responsibility (PAR) tonight.

<b>Location of eye/center:</b>	At <b>10:00 AM today</b> , the center of Tropical Depression "SAMUEL" was estimated based on all available data at <b>240 km West Northwest of Puerto Princesa City, Palawan (10.8 °N, 116.8 °E)</b>
<b>Strength:</b>	Maximum winds of up to <b>55 km/h</b> near the center and gustiness of up to <b>65 km/h</b> .
<b>Movement:</b>	Moving <b>West</b> at <b>30 km/h</b> .
<b>Forecast Positions:</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• <b>24 Hour (Tomorrow morning): 705 km West of Puerto Princesa City, Palawan (OUTSIDE PAR) (10.8°N, 112.4°E)</b></li></ul>
