- Possible raising of Tropical Cyclone Warning Signal (TCWS) No. 1 over **Northern Samar, Capiz, Iloilo and Guimaras** in the next severe weather bulletin.
- Moderate to heavy rains which may trigger flooding and landslides **is expected** over Caraga Region, Eastern Visayas, **Central Visayas** and the provinces of **Negros Occidental, Davao Oriental, Compostela Valley, Bukidnon, Misamis Oriental and Camiguin**. Residents of these areas, especially those living near or in river channels, low-lying and mountainous areas, are advised to take precautionary measures, coordinate with local disaster risk reduction and management offices, and continue monitoring for updates.
- Fisherfolks and those with small seacrafts are advised not to venture over the areas under TCWS No. 1 and the eastern and **southern** seaboards of Mindanao.
- **"SAMUEL" is expected to make landfall over the Eastern Visayas-CARAGA area tomorrow afternoon or evening.**

<b>Location of eye/center:</b>	At <b>4:00 PM</b> today, the center of Tropical Depression "SAMUEL" was estimated based on all available data at <b>505 km</b> East of Hinatuan, Surigao del Sur ( <b>8.6°N, 130.9°E</b> ).
<b>Strength:</b>	Maximum winds of up to 55 km/h near the center and gustiness of up to 65 km/h.
<b>Movement:</b>	Moving Northwest at <b>25 km/h</b>
