- Possible raising of Tropical Cyclone Warning Signal (TCWS) No. 1 over **Romblon and Cuyo Island** in the next severe weather bulletin.
- Moderate to heavy rains which may trigger flooding and landslides is expected over **Caraga Region, Northern Mindanao, Eastern Visayas, Central Visayas, and the provinces of Negros Occidental, Davao Oriental and Compostela Valley**. Residents of these areas, especially those living near or in river channels, low-lying and mountainous areas, are advised to take precautionary measures, coordinate with local disaster risk reduction and management offices, and continue monitoring for updates.
- Fisherfolks and those with small seacrafts are advised not to venture out over the areas under TCWS No. 1 and the eastern and southern seaboard of Mindanao.
- **"SAMUEL" is expected to make landfall over the Eastern Visayas-CARAGA area tomorrow evening.**

Location of eye/center:	At 10:00 PM today, the center of Tropical Depression "SAMUEL" was estimated based on all available data at 410 km East Northeast of Hinatuan, Surigao del Sur (9.1°N, 130.0°E).			
Strength:	Maximum winds of up to 55 km/h near the center and gustiness of up to 65 km/h.			
Movement:	Moving West Northwest at 20 km/h
