TROPICAL DEPRESSION "SAMUEL" HAS MAINTAINED ITS STRENGTH AS IT MOVES CLOSER TOWARD THE DINAGAT-SAMAR-LEYTE AREA.

- **Moderate to heavy rains** which may trigger flooding and landslides are expected over **Visayas, Bicol Region and the provinces of Marinduque, Romblon, Surigao del Norte, and Dinagat Islands**. Residents of these areas, especially those living near or in river channels, low-lying and mountainous areas, are advised to take precautionary measures, coordinate with local disaster risk reduction and management offices, and continue monitoring for updates.
- Fisherfolks and those with small seacrafts are advised **not to venture out** over the areas under TCWS No. 1 and the eastern seaboard of Southern Luzon.
- **"SAMUEL" is expected to make landfall over the Dinagat-Samar-Leyte area tonight.**

Location of eye/center:	At 7:00 AM today, the center of Tropical Depression "SAMUEL" was estimated based on all available data at 350 km East of Surigao City, Surigao del Norte (9.8°N, 128.7°E) .
Strength:	Maximum winds of up to 55 km/h near the center and gustiness of up to 65 km/h.
Movement:	Moving West Northwest at 20 km/h.
Forecast Positions:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 24 Hour (Tomorrow morning): In the vicinity of Mactan City, Cebu (10.5°N, 124°E) • 48 Hour (Thursday morning): 160 km Northwest of Puerto Princesa City, Palawan (10.9°N, 117.9°E) • 72 Hour (Friday morning): 610 km West Northwest of Puerto Princesa City, Palawan (OUTSIDE PAR) (11.3°N, 113.4°E) • 96 Hour (Saturday morning): 925 km West of Puerto Princesa City, Palawan (OUTSIDE PAR) (11.1°N, 110.4°E)
