TROPICAL DEPRESSION "SAMUEL" HAS SLIGHTLY SLOWED DOWN AS IT CONTINUES TO APPROACH THE LEYTE GULF AREA.


- Moderate to heavy rains which may trigger flooding and landslides is expected over **Visayas, Bicol Region, MIMAROPA, southern Quezon and Dinagat Islands**. Residents of these areas, **especially those living near or in river channels, low-lying and mountainous areas**, are advised to take appropriate measures, coordinate with local disaster risk reduction and management offices, and continue monitoring for updates.
- Fisherfolks and those with small seacrafts are advised **not to venture out** over the areas under TCWS No. 1, as well as the northern and eastern seaboard of Luzon.
- "SAMUEL" is expected to make landfall in the **area between the southern portion of Eastern Samar and Dinagat Islands tonight**.

Location of eye/center:	At 7:00 PM today, the center of Tropical Depression "SAMUEL" was estimated based on all available data at 135 km East Southeast of Guiuan, Eastern Samar (10.6°N, 126.9°E).
Strength:	Maximum winds of up to 55 km/h near the center and gustiness of up to 65 km/h .
Movement:	Moving West Northwest at 15 km/h .
