**TROPICAL DEPRESSION "SAMUEL" HAS MADE LANDFALL OVER BORONGAN CITY, EASTERN SAMAR.**

- At 2:00 AM today, TD "SAMUEL" has made landfall over Borongan City, Eastern Samar.
- Moderate to heavy rains which may trigger flooding and landslides are expected over **Western Visayas, Bicol Region, MIMAROPA and the provinces of Cebu, Negros Oriental and southern Quezon.** Residents of these areas, especially those living near or in river channels, low-lying and mountainous areas, are advised to take appropriate measures, coordinate with local disaster risk reduction and management offices, and continue monitoring for updates.
- Fisherfolks and those with small seacrafts are advised **not to venture out** over the areas under TCWS No. 1, as well as the northern and eastern seaboard of Luzon.
- **TCWS # 1 over Mindanao and Siquijor are now lifted.**

<b>Location of eye/center:</b>	At <b>1:00 AM</b> today, the center of Tropical Depression "SAMUEL" was estimated based on all available data at <b>30 km East of Borongan City, Eastern Samar (11.6°N, 125.7°E).</b>
<b>Strength:</b>	Maximum winds of up to <b>55 km/h</b> near the center and gustiness of up to <b>65 km/h.</b>
<b>Movement:</b>	Moving <b>Northwest</b> at <b>20 km/h.</b>
