**TROPICAL DEPRESSION "SAMUEL" HAS SLIGHTLY WEAKENED AND IS NOW IN THE VICINITY OF DARAM, SAMAR**

- Moderate to heavy rains which may trigger flooding and landslides are expected over **Western Visayas, Bicol Region, MIMAROPA and southern Quezon**. Residents of these areas, **especially those living near or in river channels, low-lying and mountainous areas**, are advised to take appropriate measures, coordinate with local disaster risk reduction and management offices, and continue monitoring for updates.
- Fisherfolks and those with small seacrafts are advised **not to venture out** over the areas under TCWS No. 1, as well as the northern and eastern seaboard of Luzon.
- **TCWS # 1 elsewhere is now lifted.**

<b>Location of eye/center:</b>	At <b>4:00 AM</b> today, the center of Tropical Depression "SAMUEL" was estimated based on all available data at <b>in the vicinity Daram, Samar (11.6°N, 124.8°E)</b> .
<b>Strength:</b>	Maximum winds of up to <b>45 km/h</b> near the center and gustiness of up to <b>80 km/h</b> .
<b>Movement:</b>	Moving <b>West Northwest</b> at <b>25 km/h</b> .
