TROPICAL DEPRESSION "SAMUEL" HAS ACCELERATED AND HAS MADE LANDFALL OVER ILOILO PROVINCE

- "SAMUEL" has made landfall over Barotac Nuevo, Iloilo at 9:00 AM today.
- Tropical Cyclone Warning Signal (TCWS) # 1 over Masbate (including Ticao Island), Biliran and Leyte has been lifted.
- Moderate to heavy rains which may trigger flooding and landslides are expected over MIMAROPA, CALABARZON, Western Visayas, Aurora, Camarines Norte, Camarines Sur and Catanduanes. Residents of these areas, especially those living near or in river channels, low-lying and mountainous areas, are advised to take appropriate measures, coordinate with local disaster risk reduction and management offices, and continue monitoring for updates.
- Fisherfolks and those with small seacrafts are advised **not to venture out** over the areas under TCWS No. 1, as well as the northern and eastern seaboard of Luzon.
- "SAMUEL" may exit the Philippine Area of Responsibility (PAR) between tomorrow evening and Friday morning.

Location of eye/center:	At 10:00 AM today, the center of Tropical Depression "SAMUEL" was estimated based on all available data in the vicinity of Leganes, Iloilo (10.8°N, 122.6°E).
Strength:	Maximum winds of up to 45 km/h near the center and gustiness of up to 65 km/h.
Movement:	Moving West Southwest at 40 km/h.
