**TROPICAL DEPRESSION "SAMUEL" HAS MOVED SOUTH OF CUYO ARCHIPELAGO AND IS NOW APPROACHING PALAWAN.**


- Tropical Cyclone Warning Signal (TCWS) #1 over Iloilo, Capiz, Guimaras and Romblon has been lifted.
- "SAMUEL" is expected to make landfall in Northern Palawan between tonight and tomorrow early morning.
- Moderate to heavy rains which may trigger flooding and landslides are still expected over Palawan including Calamian and Cuyo groups of islands, Aurora, Quezon, Mindoro Provinces, Panay Island, and Guimaras. Residents of these areas, especially those living near or in river channels, low-lying and mountainous areas, are advised to take appropriate measures, coordinate with local disaster risk reduction and management offices, and continue monitoring for updates.
- Fisherfolks and those with small seacrafts are advised **not to venture out** over the seaboard of areas under TCWS No. 1, as well as the eastern seaboard of Luzon.
- "SAMUEL" is expected to exit the Philippine Area of Responsibility (PAR) between tomorrow evening and Friday morning.

<b>Location of eye/center:</b>	At 7:00 PM today, the center of Tropical Depression "SAMUEL" was estimated based on all available data at 85 km Southwest of Cuyo, Palawan (10.3 °N, 120.5 °E)
<b>Strength:</b>	Maximum winds of up to 45 km/h near the center and gustiness of up to 60 km/h.
<b>Movement:</b>	Moving West at 30 km/h.
