- The center of Tropical Depression "SAMUEL" entered the PAR at 10:00 AM today.
- Tropical Cyclone Warning Signals may be raised over provinces in the eastern section of Visayas and Mindanao between tonight and tomorrow morning.
- Moderate to heavy rains which may trigger flooding and landslides may prevail over Caraga Region, Davao Oriental and Compostela Valley beginning tomorrow. Residents of these areas, especially those living near or in river channels, low-lying and mountainous areas, are advised to take precautionary measures, coordinate with local disaster risk reduction and management offices, and continue monitoring for updates.
- Fisherfolks and those with small seacrafts are advised not to venture out over the eastern seaboard of Visayas and of Mindanao due to the approaching tropical cyclone.
- Meanwhile, at 8:00 AM today, the center of Tropical Storm with International name "TORAJI" (1827) was estimated at 945 km West of Puerto Princesa City Palawan (11.1°N, 110.2°E) with maximum sustained winds of 65 km/h near the center and gustiness of up to 80 km/h. It is currently moving southwest slowly towards southern Vietnam and has no direct impact on any part of the country.

Location of eye/center:	At 10:00 AM today, the center of Tropical Depression "SAMUEL" was estimated based on all available data at 945 km East Southeast of Hinatuan, Surigao del sur (OUTSIDE PAR) (6.5°N, 135.0°E).
Strength:	Maximum sustained winds of up to 55 km/h near the center and gustiness of up to 65 km/h.
Movement:	West Southwest at 15 km/h
