TROPICAL DEPRESSION "SAMUEL" IS NOW OUTSIDE THE PHILIPPINE AREA OF RESPONSIBILITY (PAR).

- Tropical Depression "SAMUEL" left the PAR at 6:00 PM today and is now heading towards the general direction of southern Vietnam. This weather disturbance is no longer affecting any part of the country.
- Meanwhile, sea travel is risky over the seaboard of Northern Luzon due to the surge of the Northeast Monsoon.

Location of eye/center:	At 7:00 PM today , the center of Tropical Depression "SAMUEL" was estimated based on all available data at 470 km West Northwest of Puerto Princesa City, Palawan (11.2 °N, 114.7 °E)
Strength:	Maximum winds of up to 55 km/h near the center and gustiness of up to 65 km/h .
Movement:	Moving West at 30 km/h .
Forecast Positions:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 24 Hour (Tomorrow morning): 865 km West of Puerto Princesa City, Palawan (OUTSIDE PAR) (10.8°N, 110.9°E)
