AT 3:00 AM TODAY, THE CENTER OF TROPICAL DEPRESSION "SAMUEL" WAS ESTIMATED BASED ON ALL AVAILABLE DATA AT 420 KM EAST OF SURIGAO CITY, SURIGAO DEL NORTE (9.7N, 129.3E) WITH MAXIMUM SUSTAINED WINDS OF 55 KM/H NEAR THE CENTER AND GUSTINESS OF UP TO 65 KM/H. IT IS MOVING NORTHWEST AT 20 KM/H. NORTHEAST MONSOON AFFECTING NORTHERN AND CENTRAL LUZON.
