## PRESENT WEATHER:

AT 3:00 PM TODAY, THE CENTER OF TROPICAL DEPRESSION "SAMUEL" WAS ESTIMATED BASED ON ALL AVAILABLE DATA AT 260 KM EAST OF MAASIN, SOUTHERN LEYTE (10.4 N, 127.2 E) WITH MAXIMUM SUSTAINED WINDS OF 55 KM/H NEAR THE CENTER AND GUSTINESS OF UP TO 65 KM/H. IT IS MOVING NORTHWEST AT 20 KM/H. NORTHEAST MONSOON AFFECTING NORTHERN AND CENTRAL LUZON.
