PRESENT WEATHER:

AT 3:00 PM TODAY, THE CENTER OF TROPICAL DEPRESSION "SAMUEL" WAS ESTIMATED BASED ON ALL AVAILABLE DATA AT 80 KM SOUTHEAST OF CUYO, PALAWAN (10.3N, 121.5E) WITH MAXIMUM SUSTAINED WINDS OF 45 KM/H NEAR THE CENTER AND GUSTINESS OF UP TO 60 KM/H. IT IS MOVING WEST AT 30 KM/H. NORTHEAST MONSOON AFFECTING NORTHERN LUZON.

ANTIQUE – particularly Sibalom, Ipayo, Cagaranan, Palawan, Cairauan, Dalanas and Tibiao. ILOILO – particularly Pinantan, Barotac, Akalaygan, Jalaud, Jalano, Jagdong, Jalaur, Lamunan, Jaro-Agaman, Sibalom and Guimbal.

ZAMBOANGA SIBUGAY – particularly Tumaga, Taguite, Tigbao, Digsa, Sanito, Bakalan, Kabasalan and Sibuguey. ZAMBOANGA DEL SUR – particularly Kamalarang, Tupilac, Labangan and Mapangi.

In order to better inform/warn communities, you are reminded to disseminate these through local/community leaders and through your local media, including community radio stations. Conduct press briefings as often as needed. This local effort will complement and reinforce efforts at the national level. Emphasis should be on proactive actions – evacuation rather than rescue.

Let's untiringly aim for zero casualties.
