PRESENT WEATHER:

AT 3:00 PM TODAY, THE CENTER OF TROPICAL DEPRESSION "SAMUEL" WAS ESTIMATED BASED ON ALL AVAILABLE DATA AT 260 KM EAST OF MAASIN, SOUTHERN LEYTE (10.4 N, 127.2 E) WITH MAXIMUM SUSTAINED WINDS OF 55 KM/H NEAR THE CENTER AND GUSTINESS OF UP TO 65 KM/H. IT IS MOVING NORTHWEST AT 20 KM/H. NORTHEAST MONSOON AFFECTING NORTHERN AND CENTRAL LUZON.

No. 04 for Region VII (Central Visayas)

No. 04 for Region VIII (Eastern Visayas)

FORECAST 12-HR RAINFALL	Moderate to heavy rains.
WATERCOURSES STILL LIKELY TO BE AFFECTED	<p><u>Rivers and Tributaries in:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • EASTERN SAMAR – particularly Oras, Dolores, Ulot, Taft, Borongan, Suribao, Llorento, Balangiga and Sulat. • NORTHERN SAMAR – particularly Catarman, Bugko, Pambukhan, Catubig, Palapag, Maou and Gamay. • LEYTE – particularly Sangputan, Palo, Salano (Quilot), Daguitan Marabang, Cadacan, Bongquirogon, Salug, Pagbanagaran, Pagsangahan and Binahaan. • SAMAR – particularly Basey, Silaga, Calbiga and Jibatan. • BILIRAN- all rivers and its tributaries • SOUTHERN LEYTE – particularly Bisay, Himbangan and Pandan.

No. 03 for Region IX (Zamboanga Peninsula)

WATERCOURSES LIKELY TO BE AFFECTED	<p><u>Rivers and Tributaries in:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • ZAMBOANGA DEL NORTE – particularly Paro-Dapitan, Dipolog, Dikaya, Golid Duwait, Sindangan, Ingin (Maras), Palandoc, Bucas, Pataug, Quipit, Siocon, Piacan, Anungan, Pangamiran and Sibuco. • ZAMBOANGA SIBUGAY – particularly Tumaga, Taguite, Tigbao, Digma, Sanito, Bakalan, Kabasalan and Sibuguey. • ZAMBOANGA DEL SUR – particularly Kamalarang, Tupilac, Labangan and Mapangi.

No. 04 (FINAL) for Region X (Northern Mindanao)

No. 04 for Region XIII (CARAGA)

WATERCOURSES STILL LIKELY TO BE AFFECTED	<u>Rivers and Tributaries in:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• AGUSAN DEL SUR particularly Ojot, Wawa, Libang, Maosam, Kasilan, Gibong, Adgaoan, Sinulao, Kayonan and Andanan• DINAGAT ISLANDS particularly Malinao Inlet and Gaas Lulet• SURIGAO DEL NORTE particularly Surigao and Magallanes• AGUSAN DEL NORTE particularly Lake-Mainit-Tubay, Asiga, Agusan, Linugos and Cabadbaran• SURIGAO DEL SUR particularly Cantillan, Toracan, Tandag, Tago, Hubo-oteiza, Hinatuan and Bislig

People living near the mountains slopes and in the low-lying areas of the above mentioned river systems and the Local Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Councils concerned are **still advised to be alert for possible flashfloods and landslides.**
