PRESENT WEATHER:

AT 3:00 PM TODAY, THE CENTER OF TROPICAL DEPRESSION "SAMUEL" WAS ESTIMATED BASED ON ALL AVAILABLE DATA AT 80 KM SOUTHEAST OF CUYO, PALAWAN (10.3N, 121.5E) WITH MAXIMUM SUSTAINED WINDS OF 45 KM/H NEAR THE CENTER AND GUSTINESS OF UP TO 60 KM/H. IT IS MOVING WEST AT 30 KM/H. NORTHEAST MONSOON AFFECTING NORTHERN LUZON.

No. 02 for Region 4-A (CALABARZON)

WATERCOURSES STILL LIKELY TO BE AFFECTED	Rivers and Tributaries in: • QUEZON- particularly Upper Umiray, Lower Bolbok (Lawaya), Malaking-Ilog, Iyam, Macalelon, Catanauan, Silongin Lagda, Pagsanjan, Yabahaan, Bigol, Guinhalinan, Vinas, Calauag, Pandanan, Sta.Lucia, Lugan Malaybalay, Maapon, Bucal (Lalangan), Lakayat, Tignoan, Agos, Anibawan (Polilio Island) and Upper Kilbay-Catabangan • LAGUNA- particularly Pagsanjan, Pila-Sta.Cruz, San Juan and San Cristobal

WATERCOURSES STILL LIKELY TO BE AFFECTED	<u>Rivers and Tributaries in:</u> • ORIENTAL MINDORO particularly Malaylay-Baco, Pulang Tubig, Mag-asawang Tubig, Butas, Pula, Agsalin, Bansud, Samagui, Bongabon, Baroc, Bulalacao and Balete. • PALAWAN – particularly Abongan, Lian, Barabakan, Rizal, Caramay, Langogan, Babuyan, Bacungan, Iwahig Penal, Inagauan, Aborlan, Malasgao, Apurauan, Baton-baton, Aramayawan, Ihawig, Panitian, Pulot, Lamakan, Kinlugaan, Eraan, Tiga Plan, Malabangan, Ilog, Bansang, Conduaga, Culasian, Iwahig (Brookes), Okayan, Canipan and Busuanga, Coron. • OCCIDENTAL MINDORO – particularly Abra de Ilog, Cagaray, Labangan, Magbando, Lunintao, Anahawin, Monpong, Amnay, Pola, Pagbahan, Mamburao and Ibod. • MARINDUQUE – particularly Tawiran-Tagum (Marinduque) and Boac. • ROMBLON- all rivers and its tributaries

No. 04 for Region V (Bicol Region)

FORECAST 12-HR RAINFALL	Light to moderate rains
WATERCOURSES STILL LIKELY TO BE AFFECTED	<u>Rivers and Tributaries in:</u> • CATANDUANES - particularly Cabuyan, Bato and Pajo. • CAMARINES SUR – particularly Lower Kilbay, Catabangan, Ragay, Tinalmud, Tambang and Lagonoy. • CAMARINES NORTE – particularly Labo and Daet Basud. • SORSOGON – particularly Lower Donsol, Ogod, Putiao, Cadacan, Banuang-Duan, Fabrica (Tugbugan) and Matnog. • MASBATE – particularly Lanang, Mapayawan, Mandaong, Asid, Malbag, Guiom, Nainday, Daraga, Nauco (Aguada) and Beleno. • ALBAY – particularly Guinale and Upper Donsol.

No. 05 for Region VI (Western Visayas)

FORECAST 12-HR RAINFALL	Light to moderate rains
WATERCOURSES STILL LIKELY TO BE AFFECTED	<u>Rivers and Tributaries in:</u> • CAPIZ – particularly Panay, Mambusao, Panay Malinao, Alingon and Balantian. • AKLAN – particularly Ibajay, Aklan and Jalo. • NEGROS OCCIDENTAL – particularly Malogo, Sicaba, Grande, Himocaaan, Danao, Upper Tyabanan, Sipalay and Lower Ilog. • ANTIQUE – particularly Sibalom, Ipayo, Cagaranan, Palawan, Cairauan, Dalanas and Tibiao. • ILOILO – particularly Pinantan, Barotac, Akalaygan, Jalaud, Jalano, Jagdong, Jalaur, Lamunan, Jaro-Agaman, Sibalom and Guimbal.

No. 06 for Region VII (Central Visayas)

FORECAST 12-HR RAINFALL	Light to moderate rains
WATERCOURSES STILL LIKELY TO BE AFFECTED	Rivers and Tributaries in: • NEGROS ORIENTAL – particularly Libertad, Tanjay, Candugay, Siaton, Cauitan, Sipocong, Bayawan, Pagatban and Lower Tyabanan.

No. 06 (FINAL) for Region VIII (Eastern Visayas)

FORECAST 12-HR RAINFALL	Light rains
WATERCOURSES NO LONGER TO BE AFFECTED	Rivers and Tributaries in: • EASTERN SAMAR – particularly Oras, Dolores, Ulot, Taft, Borongan, Suribao, Llorento, Balangiga and Sulat. • NORTHERN SAMAR – particularly Catarman, Bugko, Pambukhan, Catubig, Palapag, Maou and Gamay. • LEYTE – particularly Sangputan, Palo, Salano (Quilot), Daguitan Marabang, Cadacan, Bongquirogon, Salug, Pagbanagaran, Pagsangahan and Binahaan. • SAMAR – particularly Basey, Silaga, Calbiga and Jibatan. • BILIRAN- all rivers and its tributaries • SOUTHERN LEYTE – particularly Bisay, Himbangan and Pandan.
With this development and unless significant rain occurs, this is the final General Flood Advisory for this event.	

No. 05 (FINAL) for Region IX (Zamboanga Peninsula)

FORECAST 12-HR RAINFALL	Light rains
WATERCOURSES NO LONGER LIKELY TO BE AFFECTED	Rivers and Tributaries in: • ZAMBOANGA DEL NORTE – particularly Paro-Dapitan, Dipolog, Dikaya, Golid Duwait, Sindangan, Ingin (Maras), Palandoc, Bucas, Pataug, Quipit, Siocon, Piacan, Anungan, Pangamiran and Sibuco. • ZAMBOANGA SIBUGAY – particularly Tumaga, Taguite, Tigbao, Digma, Sanito, Bakalan, Kabasalan and Sibuguey. • ZAMBOANGA DEL SUR – particularly Kamalarang, Tupilac, Labangan and Mapangi.
With this development and unless significant rain occurs, this is the final General Flood Advisory for this event.
