<b>THE NORTHERN SEABOARD OF NORTHERN LUZON</b> (Northern coast of Ilocos Norte, Batanes and Babuyan Islands)	Cloudy skies with light rains	(45-63) / (24-34)	Rough to Very Rough	2.8 – 4.5
<b>THE WESTERN SEABOARD OF NORTHERN LUZON</b> (Western coast of Ilocos Norte)	Partly cloudy skies	(45-63) / (24-34)	Rough to Very Rough	2.8 – 4.5
