THE EASTERN SEABOARDS OF NORTHERN AND CENTRAL LUZON (Eastern Coast of Cagayan, Isabela, and Aurora)	Partly cloudy to cloudy skies with isolated rainshowers or thunderstorms	(45-63) / (24-34)	Rough to Very Rough	2.8 - 4.5
