<b>THE EASTERN SEABOARDS OF CENTRAL AND SOUTHERN LUZON</b> (Aurora, Camarines Provinces, Catanduanes, eastern coast of Albay, eastern coast of Sorsogon, and eastern coast of Quezon including Polilio Island)	Cloudy skies with scattered rainshowers and thunderstorms	(45 - 63 / 24 - 34)	Rough to very rough	2.8 – 4.5
<b>THE EASTERN SEABOARD OF VISAYAS</b> (Samar and Leyte)	Partly cloudy to cloudy skies with isolated rainshowers or thunderstorms	(45 - 63 / 24 - 34)	Rough to very rough	2.8 – 4.5
