**STRONG TO GALE FORCE WINDS IS EXPECTED TO AFFECT THE FOLLOWING AREAS:**

<b>THE EASTERN SEABOARD OF MINDANAO</b> (Dinagat Island, Eastern coast of Surigao provinces including Siargao, and eastern coast of Davao Oriental)	Cloudy skies with light rains	(45-63) / (24-34)	Rough to very rough	2.8 – 4.5
<b>THE EASTERN SEABOARDS VISAYAS</b> (Northern Samar, and Eastern Samar)	Cloudy skies with light rains	(45 - 63) / (24 - 34)	Rough to very rough	2.8 – 4.5
