STRONG TO GALE FORCE WINDS ARE EXPECTED TO AFFECT THE FOLLOWING AREAS:

THE WESTERN SEABOARDS OF SOUTHERN LUZON (Palawan and Occidental Mindoro)	Monsoon Rains	45 - 63 / 24 - 34	Rough to very rough	2.8 - 4.5
THE NORTHERN AND EASTERN SEABOARDS OF NORTHERN LUZON (Batanes, Calayan, Babuyan, Northern coast of Ilocos Norte, Isabela, and Cagayan)	Cloudy skies with scattered rainshowers and thunderstorms	45 - 63 / 24 - 34	Rough to very rough	2.8 - 4.5
