<b>THE WESTERN SEABOARDS OF SOUTHERN LUZON AND OF VISAYAS</b> (Palawan, Occidental Mindoro, Negros Occidental, Guimaras, Iloilo, Aklan and Antique)	Cloudy skies with scattered rainshowers and thunderstorms	45 - 63 / 24 - 34	Rough to very rough	2.8 - 4.5
<b>THE EASTERN SEABOARD OF VISAYAS</b> (Northern Samar and Eastern Samar)	Partly cloudy to cloudy skies with isolated rainshowers or thunderstorms	45 - 63 / 24 - 34	Rough to very rough	2.8 - 4.5
