THE EASTERN SEABOARD OF SOUTHERN LUZON AND VISAYAS (Catanduanes, eastern coast of Albay, Eastern coast of Sorsogon, Northern Samar, and Eastern Samar)	Partly cloudy to cloudy skies with isolated light rains	(45 - 63) / (24 - 34)	Rough to very rough	2.8 – 4.5
