## **Present Weather:**

At 3:00 PM today, the Low-Pressure Area (LPA) was estimated at 280 km southeast of Hinatuan, Surigao del Sur (6.3°N, 127.8 °E). Trough of LPA affecting the eastern sections of Visayas and Mindanao.

No. 3 for Region VIII (Eastern Visayas)

No. 17 for Region XIII (CARAGA)

WATER COURSES LIKELY TO BE AFFECTED	<ul> <li>Rivers and its tributaries particularly:</li> <li>Surigao Del Norte – Surigao and Magallanes</li> <li>Agusan Del Sur – Ojot, Wawa, Libang, Maosam, Kasilan, Gibong, Adgaoan, Sinulao, Kayonan and Andanan.</li> <li>Agusan Del Norte – Lake-Mainit-Tubay, Asiga, Agusan, Linugos, and Cabadbaran.</li> <li>Surigao Del Sur – Cantillan, Toracan, Tandag, Tago, Hubo-Oteiza, Hinatuan and Bislig.</li> </ul>

People living near the mountains slopes and in the low-lying areas of the abovementioned river systems and the Local Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Councils concerned are **advised to take appropriate actions**.

You are hereby directed to undertake precautionary measures and monitor the situation in your AOR. Likewise, the public and Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Councils (DRRMCs) concerned are advised to take precautions and appropriate actions.

In order to better inform/warn communities, you are reminded to disseminate these through local/community leaders and through your local media, including community radio stations. Conduct press briefings as often as needed. This local effort will complement and reinforce efforts at the national level. Emphasis should be on proactive actions – evacuation rather than rescue.

Let's untiringly aim for zero casualty.
