No. 01 for Region V (Bicol Region)

FORECAST 12-HR RAINFALL	Light to moderate rains
WATERCOURSES LIKELY TO BE AFFECTED	 Rivers and Tributaries in: Camarines Sur - particularly Lower Kilbay Catabangan, Ragay, Tinalmud, Tambang and Lagonoy Catanduanes - particularly Cabuyan, Bato and Pajo. Camarines Norte - particularly Labo and Daet Basud. Sorsogon - particularly Lower Donsol, Ogod, Putiao, Cadacan, Banuang-Duan, Fabrica (Tugbugan) and Matnog. Masbate - particularly Lanang, Mapayawan, Mandaong, Asid, Malbag, Guiom, Nainday, Daraga, Nauco (Aguada) and Beleno. Albay - particularly Guinale and Upper Donsol.

No. 01 for Region VIII (Easter Visayas)

FORECAST 12-HR RAINFALL	Light to moderate rains
WATERCOURSES LIKELY TO BE AFFECTED	 Rivers and Tributaries in: Northern Samar - particularly Catarman, Bugko, Pambukhan, Catubig, Palapag, Maou and Gamay. Leyte - particularly Sangputan, Palo, Salano (Quilot), Daguitan Marabang, Cadacan, Bongquirogon, Salug, Pagbanagaran, Pagsangahan and Binahaan. Southern Leyte - particularly Bisay, Himbangan and Pandan. Biliran - All rivers and its tributaries Samar - particularly Basey, Silaga, Calbiga and Jibatan. Easter Samar - particularly Oras, Dolores, Ulot, Taft, Borongan, Suribao, Llorento, Balangiga and Sulat.

People living near the mountain slopes and in the low-lying areas of the abovementioned river systems and the LDRRMCs concerned advised to take necessary precautionary measures.

In order to better inform/warn communities, you are reminded to disseminate these through local/community leaders and through your local media, including community radio stations. Conduct press briefings as often as needed. This local effort will complement and reinforce efforts at the national level. Emphasis should be on proactive actions – evacuation rather than rescue.

Let's untiringly aim for zero casualty.
