At 3:00 PM today, Tropical Depression "JENNY" was estimated based on all available data at 680km east of Virac, Catanduanes (14.1°N, 130.5°E), with maximum sustained winds of 45 km/h near the center and gustiness of up to 55 km/h. It is moving Northwest at 25 km/h. Southwest monsoon affecting the western sections of Southern Luzon and Visayas.

No. 01 for Region IV-A (CALABARZON)

FORECAST 12-HR RAINFALL	Light to moderate rains
WATERCOURSES LIKELY TO BE AFFECTED	 Rivers and Tributaries in: Quezon - particularly upper Umiray, lower Bolbok (Lawaya), Malaking-ilog, Iyam, Macalelon, Catanauan, Silongin Lagda, Pagsanjan, Yabahaan, Bigol, Guinhalinan, Vinas, Calauag, Pandanan, Sta. Lucia, Lugan Malaybalay, Maapon, Bucal (Lalangan), Lakayat, Tignoan, Agos, Anibawan (Polilio Island) and Upper Kilbay – Catabangan. Laguna - particularly Pagsanjan, Pila-Sta. Cruz, San Juan, and San Cristobal Cavite - particularly Laboc (Balsahan), Cañas, Ilang-ilang, and Imus Rizal - particularly upper Marikina and Kaliwa Batangas - particularly Lian, Banabang-Molino, Pansipit, Kapumpong, Rosario-Lobo, and upper Bolbok (Lawaya)

No. 02 for Region V (Bicol Region)

FORECAST 12-HR RAINFALL	Light to moderate rains
WATERCOURSES STILL LIKELY TO BE AFFECTED	 Rivers and Tributaries in: Camarines Sur - particularly Lower Kilbay Catabangan, Ragay, Tinalmud, Tambang and Lagonoy Catanduanes - particularly Cabuyan, Bato and Pajo.



•	Camarines Norte - particularly Labo and Daet Basud. Sorsogon - particularly Lower Donsol, Ogod, Putiao, Cadacan, Banuang-Duan, Fabrica (Tugbugan) and Matnog. Masbate - particularly Lanang, Mapayawan, Mandaong, Asid, Malbag, Guiom, Nainday, Daraga, Nauco (Aguada)
	and Beleno.
•	Albay - particularly Guinale and Upper Donsol.

No. 02 for Region VIII (Eastern Visayas)

FORECAST 12-HR RAINFALL	Light to moderate rains
WATERCOURSES STILL LIKELY TO BE AFFECTED	 Rivers and Tributaries in: Northern Samar - particularly Catarman, Bugko, Pambukhan, Catubig, Palapag, Maou and Gamay. Leyte - particularly Sangputan, Palo, Salano (Quilot), Daguitan Marabang, Cadacan, Bongquirogon, Salug, Pagbanagaran, Pagsangahan and Binahaan. Southern Leyte - particularly Bisay, Himbangan and Pandan. Biliran - All rivers and its tributaries Samar - particularly Basey, Silaga, Calbiga and Jibatan. Easter Samar - particularly Oras, Dolores, Ulot, Taft, Borongan, Suribao, Llorento, Balangiga and Sulat.

People living near the mountain slopes and in the low-lying areas of the abovementioned river systems and the LDRRMCs concerned are advised to take necessary precautionary measures.

In order to better inform/warn communities, you are reminded to disseminate these through local/community leaders and through your local media, including community radio stations. Conduct press briefings as often as needed. This local effort will complement and reinforce efforts at the national level. Emphasis should be on proactive actions – evacuation rather than rescue.

Let's untiringly aim for zero casualty.
